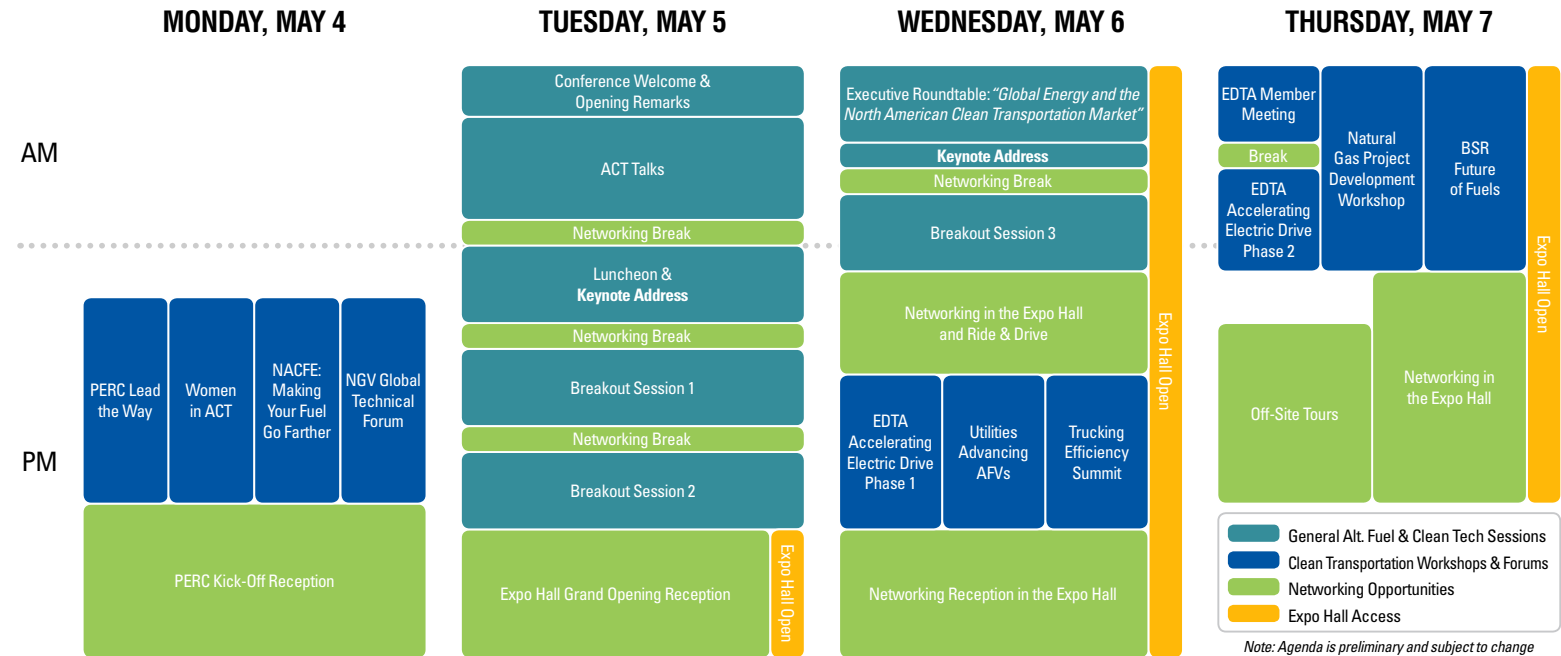

Stop 3: Westport WiNG Plant – Gain a behind-the-scenes look at Westport’s 90,000-square-foot light-duty, natural gas vehicle conversion facility where its WiNG Power System and CNG fuel tanks are installed on Ford vehicles.



TOUR 2 | Presented by Cambrian Energy & Questar Fueling

Stop 1: McCommas Bluff Biomethane Facility – Get an inside look at this innovative waste-to-energy facility to learn how methane is collected from the landfill, cleaned, and dispensed into the Atmos pipeline.

Stop 2: Questar Fueling CNG Station – See one of the largest fast-fill CNG stations in North America, a fast-fill heavy-duty truck fueling station with six fueling lanes and three dual-hose dispensers that can accommodate all CNG vehicle types.

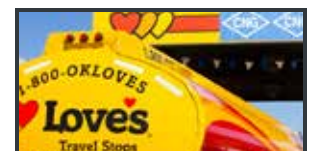


TOUR 3 | Presented by Love’s & Dallas County Schools

Stop 1: Dallas County Schools – Home to the largest propane school bus fleet in Texas (560 buses), Dallas County Schools is offering an inside look at their service center featuring a propane autogas fueling station and biodiesel production facility.

Stop 2: Love’s Travel Stops & Country Stores CNG Station – Gain a behind-the-scenes look at Love’s brand-new Dallas CNG station, which offers fast-fill for heavy-duty trucks using two high-flow dispensers, as well as a CNG fueling option for traditional autos with a total capacity of 1,200 GGE per hour.

Stop 3: City of Cedar Hill – Explore this Government Center featuring a solar PV system, a wind turbine, two all-electric Nissan Leafs, four EV charging stations, and a real-time monitoring system that allows citizens to view the amount of energy generated onsite.

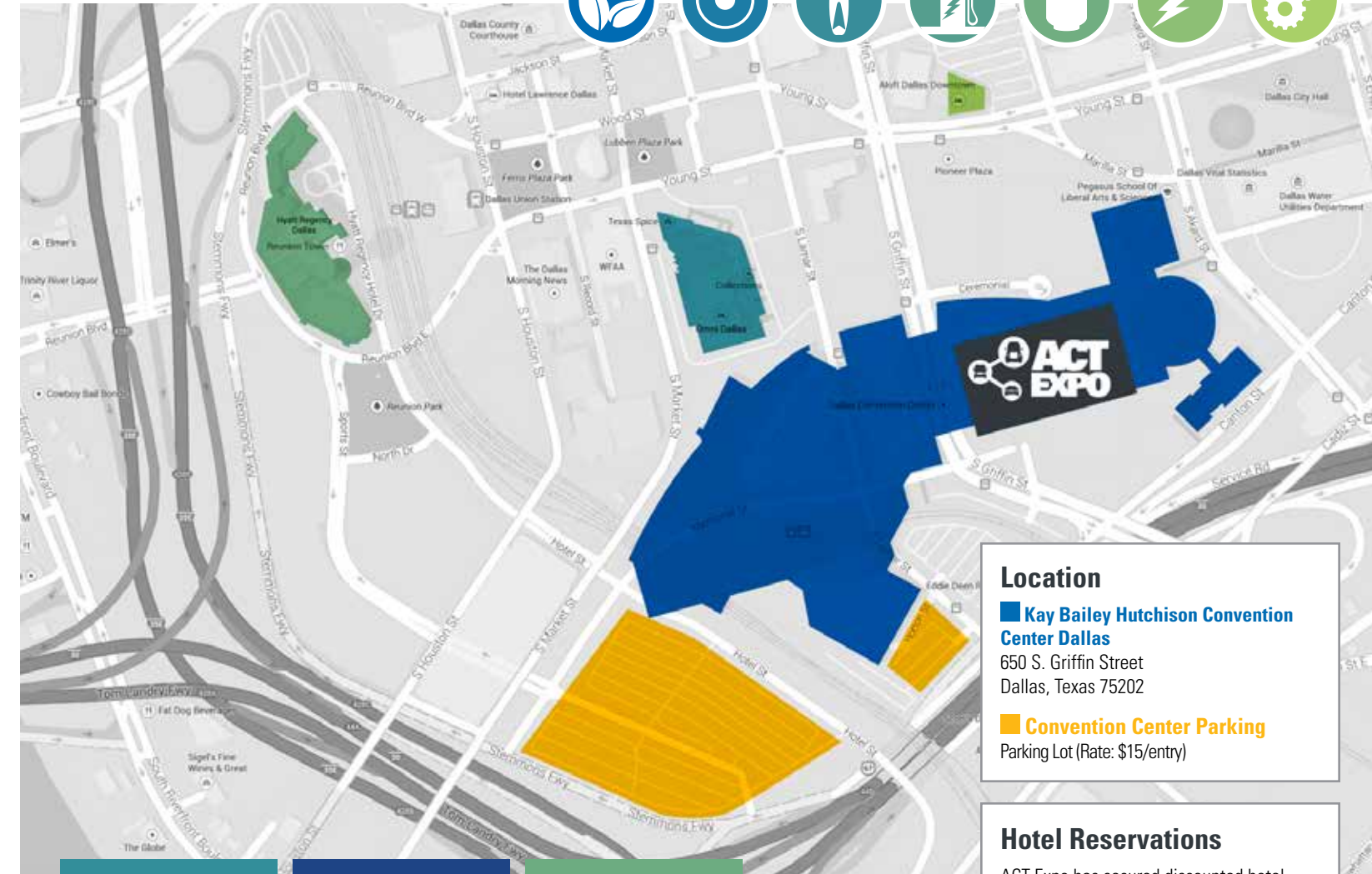
